The movement inspires me daily, not just because it provides meals to those in need, but because it creates spaces for meaningful discussions and learning among people often overlooked by the system."





This could be 350kg of spaetzle dough (German egg pasta) or a pallet of sliced tomatoes. Foodsharing works if people put their heart and soul into it - and they do!"


