It's remarkable how naturally they discuss conflicts and find ways to improve things for everyone. For me, this place is special not only for the children's growth but also for its connection to the wider Can Battlò neighborhood, where local initiatives thrive."



Redistributing money between individuals



"People often write to us telling us their story and justifying their need for money. When we reply that we don't need to be given any reasons, people react with relief and sometimes disbelief that "something like this" even exists. Receiving money without having to prove your need is practically unheard of. It motivates us to create a system of give and take that is completely different from our supposed welfare state: a visionary

system based on trust and goodwill. In our society, it is always the poor who have to justify themselves, never the rich - despite mass low taxation of wealth and tax evasion by the super-rich. However, more and more people and initiatives are denouncing this and calling for political change (such as the European Citizens' Initiative for a European Wealth Tax). That gives us hope."

After our first year of using plenty of mulch, we were overjoyed to harvest celery, revealing active soil life and beautiful celery bulbs beneath the fertile soil."

Campaigns for the socialization of housing, organizes referendums, and raises awareness about housing issues and public control of rent levels and building management.

"I moved to Berlin for the freedom and diversity it offers, but rising rents and corporate interests threaten that. That's why I joined DWE, to fight for a democratically organized economy where housing is common property and managed with community participation. We don't want to leave housing to the state alone, but involve tenants, workers, and the urban community. Initiatives like DWE give me hope for an economy focused on public well-being. Together, we can find democratic solutions that meet the needs of both people and the environment."

"Food not Bombs" is an anarchist initiative that began in the USA in the 1980s and has grown into a global movement of independent collectives.

LOCATION

Active worldwide, with collectives in Tel-Aviv, Haifa, and Jerusalem, particularly focused on protests against the war on Gaza.

VALUES

protests government priorities that favor war over basic human needs, solidarity and food security.

ACTIVITIES

Collects discarded food, cooks it, and shares it with the public through weekly stalls, highlighting food waste and resource misallocation.

GOAL

To protest war spending and promote food justice by redistributing surplus food to those in need, especially in the context of current protests against the Gaza blockade.

"Being part of Food not Bombs has shown me how food is used as a political tool rather than a basic human right. FNB isn't charity—it's solidarity, challenging the idea of "less fortunate" by addressing food insecurity as a political choice. The movement inspires me daily, not just because it provides meals to those in need, but because it creates spaces for meaningful discussions and learning among people often overlooked by the system."

This could be 350kg of spaetzle dough (German egg pasta) or a pallet of sliced tomatoes. Foodsharing works if people put their heart and soul into it - and they do!"


