The problem with (electric) vehicles



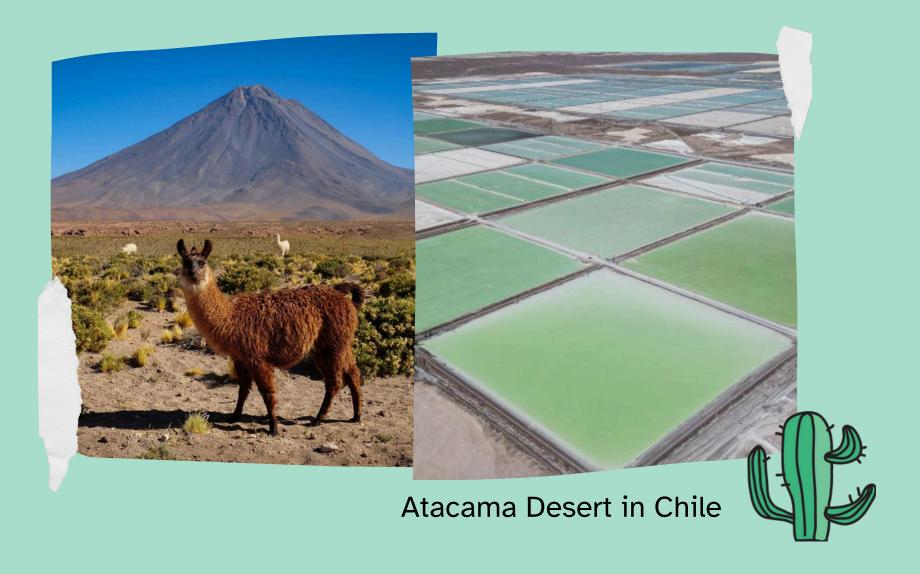
Vehicle traffic is a climate killer - in Germany alone it is responsible for 100 million tonnes of CO² per year.
